Upon entry to your select location, the screen will prompt your resident, guest or staff member to walk towards it.

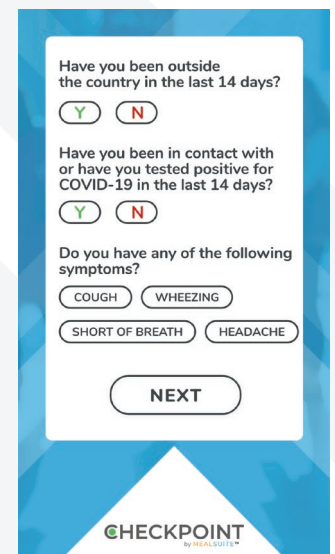
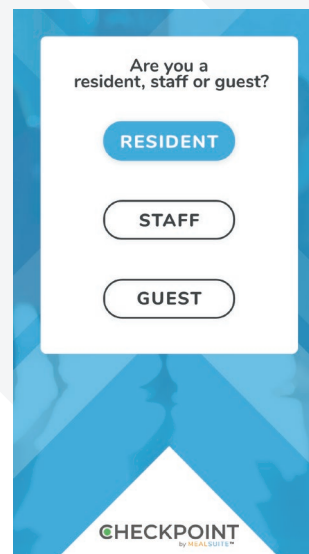
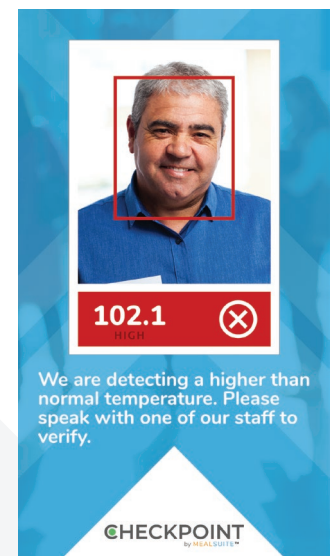
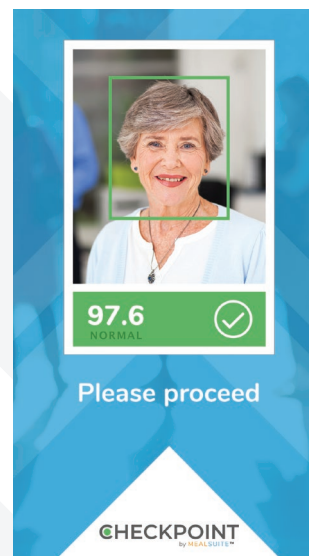
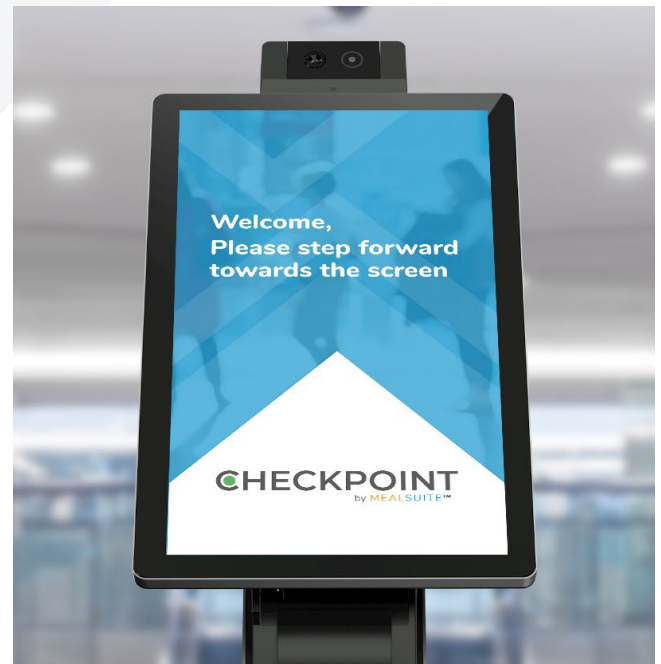
Once within 3 feet, the screen will validate their thermal temperature using the on-board thermal camera while conducting facial recognition.

Upon a successful reading, the screen and its surrounding lights turn green and advise the individual to proceed. In the event of a high temperature, screen lights will turn red and prompt an appropriate response based on the circumstance.

[Optional] Collecting information from non-residents?

Activate the automated prompt for a guest to enter their name and telephone number before proceeding. Or, have questions to ask your diners such as 'Have you recently travelled out of country?'. Add the available self-assessment questionnaire module.

Dining Room

With communities reopening their dining rooms across the country, it's more important than ever to add an extra layer of safety to mealtime. With Checkpoint by MealSuite™, easily and instantly validate your patient and resident temperatures before they're seated for their meals. In the event of a high temperature, the screen and lights will turn red and prompt the user to speak with a staff member.

Have MealSuite Point of Sale?

Residents and guests will automatically appear on the screen for the hostess to seat them. In the event of a high temperature reading, it will trigger an alert on the tablet with the guest's photo or resident's name and the associated temperature reading.

Not using MealSuite Point of Sale?

Use the standalone check-in app on an iOS or Android device to monitor who has signed in and track their temperature.



Front Desk

Upon entry to a building, have a kiosk waiting for residents, guests and staff. The screen prompts the individual to walk towards the screen and advises it will be taking their photo and temperature. Upon a successful reading, it checks to see if the person has ever completed the process before. If they are a resident or known staff member, they will be notified to proceed after a valid temperature is sensed. If they indicate a fever, a notice will be sent to the nearby monitoring tablet or an automated e-mail/text message can be triggered to staff.



Staff Sign-In

Validate that your staff are within an appropriate temperature range by making the screen available near time clock check-in points. A historical log of all temperature checks is kept, including a photo of the staff member and their registered temperature.
